
3. INDIAN AIRFORCE DAY


12. SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME



17. ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAMME



23. PAMPHLET DISTRIBUTION OF WOMEN HELPLINE NUMBERS


On 7th march NSS volunteers of St. John's College, Anchal distributed pamphlets printed with women helpline numbers in shops, bus stands, auto stand etc.

A speech competition on the topic, "Role of Youth in nation building "was conducted under the auspices of our NSS unit .




27. Transgender awareness Programme.

Our unit organized a meeting for appreciating our program officer, Shijo sir for his achievement as best program officer, (university level).




36. Seven Day Leadership Camp
