"Why I am Not a Cricket Historian"

Souvik Naha is a widely published historian of modern India and he has studied leisure cultures predominantly through the prism of cricket. He is the editor of *Global and Transnational Sport: Ambiguous Borders, Connected Domains* (Routledge, 2018) and the co-editor of *Ethical Concerns in Sport Governance* (Routledge, 2019) and *FIFA World Cup and Beyond Sport, Culture, Media and Governance* (Routledge, 2018). He has published several widely cited essays in prestigious sports studies journals and edited volumes. His monograph, *A Field Full of Shades: Cricket in Modern India* (Cambridge University Press) is forthcoming in 2021.

He is associated with several sports studies journals. He serves as the Associate Editor of *Sport in Society*, Editor of *Sport in History*, and Book Reviews Editor of *Soccer & Society*.

Claire Westall publishes regularly on literature and sport, especially on cricket, and her chapter "Reading Brian Lara and the Traditions of Caribbean Cricket Poetry" is included in the *The Cambridge Companion to Cricket* (2011), edited by Jeff Hill and Anthony Bateman. Her forthcoming monograph is titled *The Rites of Cricket and Caribbean Literature* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2021).

She has published widely on other areas of literature as well. She is the co-author of *The Public on the Public: The British Public as Trust, Reflexivity and Political Foreclosure* (Palgrave, 2015), and the co-editor of three books: *Cross-Gendered Literary Voices: Appropriating, Resisting, Embracing* (Palgrave, 2012), *Literature of an Independent England: Revisions of England, Englishness and English Literature* (Palgrave, 2013), and *Prison Writing and the Literary World: Imprisonment, Institutionalization and Questions of Literary Practice* (Routledge, 2020).

"Nationalism, Capitalism and Social Exclusion: Cricket in India"


Nissim Mannathukkaren's main research interests are focused on left/communist movements, development and democracy, modernity, the politics of popular culture (especially, the politics of mass cultural forms like the media, cinema and sport), and Marxist and postcolonial theories. He is the author of *The Rupture with Memory: Derrida and the Specters that Haunt Marxism* (Navayana, 2006) and his articles have appeared in such prestigious journals as *Inter-Asia Cultural Studies*, *Dialectical Anthropology*, and *Third World Quarterly*.

His is a significant voice in the debates on cricket in India and he has explored the sport from the perspectives of both caste and class. His widely cited essays on cricket have appeared in *The International Journal of History of Sport* and *the Economic and Political Weekly* as well as in the newspaper *The Hindu*.

Prof. Eric Wolanski is a coastal oceanographer and ecohydrologist. His specialization is linking physics and biology in estuarine, coastal, reef and savannah ecosystems. He is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Technological Sciences and Engineering, the Institution of Engineers Australia (ret.), and l' Academie Royale des Sciences d'Outre-Mer (Belgium). He was awarded an Australian Centenary medal for services in estuarine and coastal oceanography, a Doctorate Honoris Causa from the Catholic University of Louvain in Belgium, a 2nd Doctorate Honoris Causa by the University of Hull in the UK. A Queensland Information Technology and Telecommunication award for excellence, First Life- Time Achievement Award of the Estuarine & Coastal Science Association (ECSA).
