## **Report of the Webinar**

An international webinar was conducted on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023, on the topic "Intellectual Property Management in Research Environments," organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at St. John's College, Anchal. The chief spokesperson was SumitLuthra, a senior Intellectual Property (IP) manager at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology, Trondheim. He is an IP professional with extensive experience in IP Management & Patent licensing in ICT, Robotics, Machine Learning, Artificial Intelligence, and Engineering domains. He has worked for Fortune 500 companies and SMEs across Europe, Asia, and the Asia Pacific region.

Mr.Sumit explained that intellectual property management in universities and colleges involves safeguarding the creations of students, faculty, and staff, such as inventions, research findings, and artistic works. He emphasized that universities often establish policies and procedures to govern the ownership, protection, and commercialization of intellectual property developed within their institutions. Additionally, Mr.Sumit highlighted the importance of effective management of intellectual property in fostering innovation, attracting funding, and facilitating collaborations between academia and industry. A total of 97 participants including both the students and faculties of St. John's College, Anchal have participated in the webinar.
