Anti-Ragging Cell


Report of the Academic Year 2022-23

With the aim of making the campus ragging-free, Anti-Ragging cell ensures the safety of the freshers. Anti-ragging cell was constituted in the academic year 2022-23 with Dr Mary M. Abraham as the convener. The Principal is the Chairman of the Committee. Mr Sibi C. Babu, Dr Ronie Thomas, Ms Lalitha Joseph and Dr Brilliant Rajan are the members.

A joint meeting of the anti-ragging cell and squad was convened on June 17, 2022. The decisions of the meeting:

- At the time of admission, the students are required to sign an affidavit promising not to engage in any form of ragging on campus. The parent's signature is also acquired on the declaration that their child will not participate in ragging.
- To display anti-ragging posters.
- The Anti-Ragging squad will monitor places like hostel, canteens, play grounds, classrooms, and other places where there is students' presence.
- To inform all students about the measures adopted by the college to curb ragging through notices.
- To sensitize students about the harmful effects of ragging and the disciplinary actions that will be taken against offenders.
- To investigate complaints related to ragging promptly and impartially.
