Report of Anti Ragging Squad 2018-2019

With the intention of preventing ragging and to take anti-ragging measures in the college, an anti-ragging squad was constituted in accordance with the directive of Government. The committee for the academic year 2018-2019 was formed under the chairmanship of the principal of the college Rev. Fr Johnson G. Dr Benny Thomas served as the convener of the committee with Mr S S Sumesh, Mr K C Bright, Mr A R Twinkle, Dr Deepa Mary Joseph and Mr Tony Philip, representatives from administrative staff and students of UG and PG courses as the members.

Apart from providing the students with college calendar detailing the names of the faculties to contact if and when required, toll free number and email ID for filing the complaint was also given. The committee also put up notice in the college premises as per UGC rules depicting the provisions of penal law applicable to incident of ragging and the punishment thereof.

The committee convened a meeting for the semester 1 students soon after their admission to inform them about their rights and instruct them about how they should act if there is any occurrence of ragging. The faculty advisors of each batch were instructed to interact with the students of their department encourages them to react and report in the case of ragging in the college or in the hostel. The committee made sure to generate awareness among students on anti-ragging.

No incident of ragging was reported in the reporting year. While the absence of formal complaints is encouraging, The Anti-ragging squad remains vigilant in its commitment to ensuring a safe and respectful campus environment.
