#### 1. WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY - 5 JUNE 2021



#### 2. MULLAPPU - ANGANAWADI VISIT - 19 JUNE 2021



#### 12. OPPAM - SEVEN DAY SPECIAL CAMP - 22-28 DECEMBER 2021


#### **DAY 1: 22 DECEMBER 2021**


#### **DAY 2: 23 DECEMBER 2021**








#### **DAY 5: 26 DECEMBER 2021**








#### **DAY 6: 27 DECEMBER 2021**




#### **DAY 7: 28 DECEMBER 2021**



#### 14. NCC NATIONAL YOUTH FESTIVAL - 12 JANUARY 2022



#### 15. COVID WARRIORS - 4 FEBRUARY 2022



#### 16. ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAM - 13 FEBRUARY 2022



#### 17. BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM - 17 FEBRUARY 2022



#### 18. STAND WITH HER- INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY - 3-8 MARCH 2022




