








8. VOLUNTEER LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMME - 23-25 AUGUST 2022

10. BODHYAM QUIZ - 12 OCTOBER 2022




14. NATIONAL ADVENTURE CAMP - 29 OCTOBER 2022 - 7 NOVEMBER 2022




16. ANTI-NARCOTIC HUMAN CHAIN DATE: 1 NOVEMBER 2022








20. CONSTITUTION DAY - 25 NOVEMBER 2022








23. HUMAN RIGHTS DAY - 14 DECEMBER 2022









SECOND DAY (26/12/2022)








26. BASHEER'S BIRTH ANNIVERSARY DATE: 21 JANUARY 2023



29. GLOBAL SCIENCE FOR GLOBAL WELLBEING – NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY


DATE: 28 FEBRUARY 2023


31. SURVEY DATE: 25 MARCH 2023
