Minority Cell Report - 2022-23

On August 25, 2022, a meeting of the Minority Cell was convened in the presence of the principal and the Minority Cell convener. The meeting aimed to raise awareness among minority students about available scholarships and the functions of the grievance cell. An informative session was conducted to ensure that minority students were well-informed about the opportunities and support mechanisms available to them within the college. Additionally, a significant event organized by the Kerala Government Minority Welfare Department took place on Saturday, February 25, 2023. This event was a one-day personality development and career guidance camp held at St. John's College, Anchal. The camp witnessed the participation of 100 students and faculty members from four colleges: St. Stephens College, Pathanapuram, NSS College, Nilamel, SN College, Punalur, and St. John's College, Anchal. The inauguration of the camp was carried out by Smt. Radha Rajendran, President of Anchal Block Panchayat, and it concluded at 5:30 PM.

During the academic year 2022-23, a UGC/CSIR NET coaching program sponsored by the Directorate of Minority Welfare, Government of Kerala was organized in the college. The program was inaugurated on 17 December 2022. Classes started from 17 December 2022. PG students and pass out Pg students of St. John's college and students from other colleges were selected for the coaching. The coaching classes ended on 11 February 2023.

Furthermore, during the academic year, six students were selected for the C H Muhammad Koya Scholarship. These scholarships aim to provide financial assistance to deserving minority students, reflecting the college's commitment to supporting their academic pursuits.
