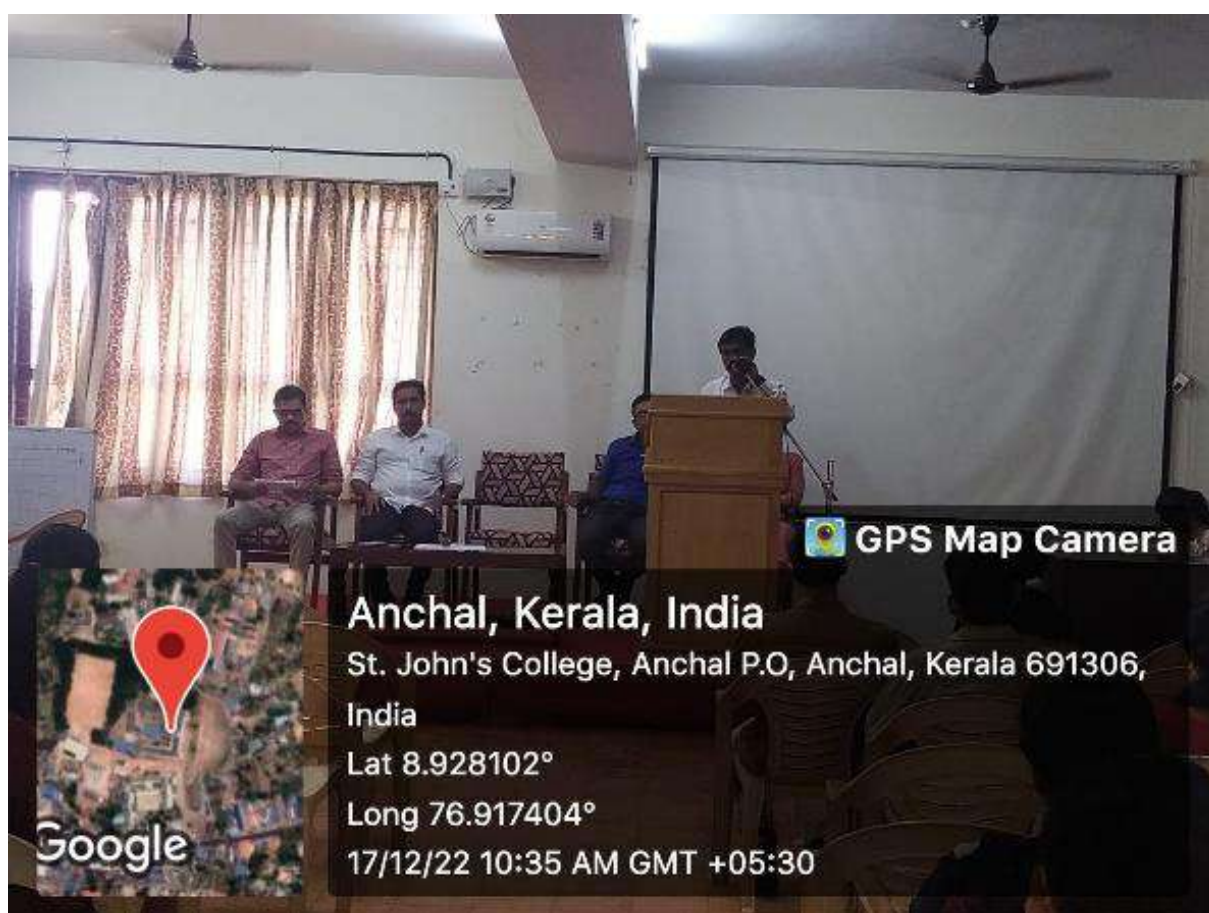
Programme Report

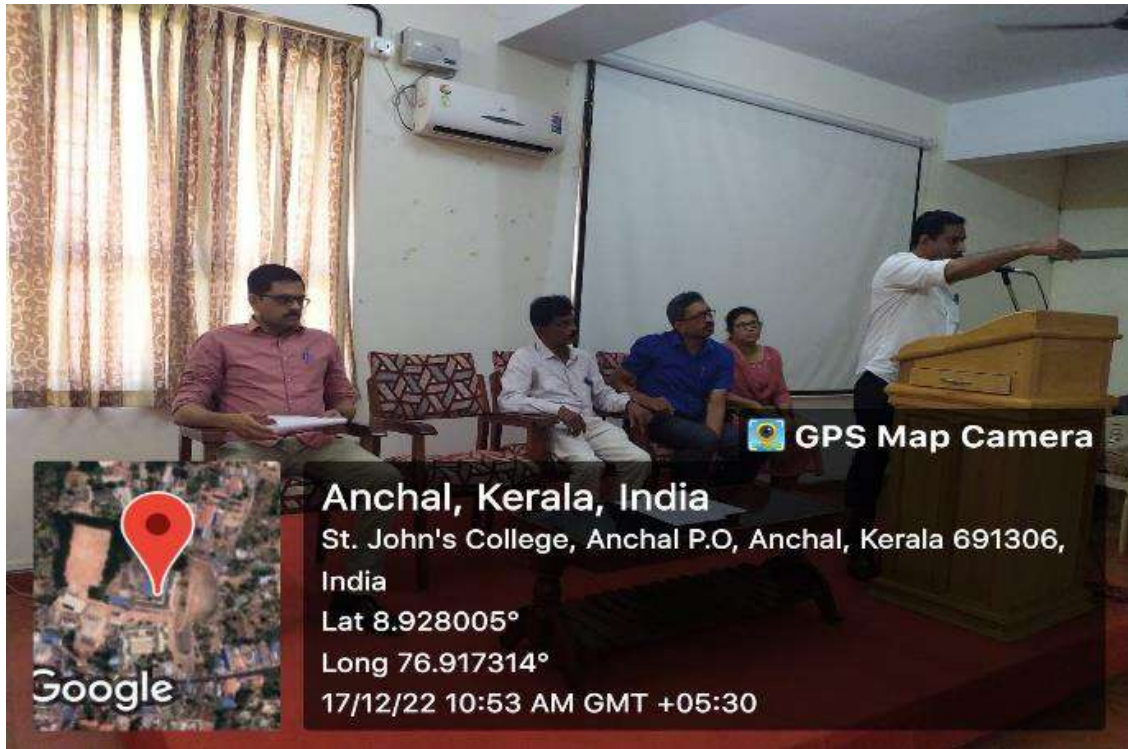
Programme Report

The St John's College Anchal has organized a UGC/CSIR-NET Coaching programme sponsored by the Directorate of Minority Welfare, Government of Kerala. The programme was inaugurated on 17th December 2022. The programme started at 10.00 am with a prayer song followed by a welcome speech by Dr Anila George, the course coordinator. She explained the objectives of the coaching programme and welcomed the gathering. The meeting was inaugurated by Dr Cherian John Principal, of St. John's College who delivered a wonderful inaugural talk on the importance of the programme in our college for the students. Prof. Sibi C. Babu, HOD of Mathematics and Convenor of the Academic Audit Committee, Dr Thomas Mathew, HOD Dept of Chemistry offered felicitations. The inaugural session concluded with a vote of thanks by Prof Jerry C Jacson, HOD of Botany and IQAC Coordinator.

The class for Chemistry and Mathematics started from 17 December 2022. The first year, second-year and pass out PG students of Chemistry and Mathematics of St John's college and from other colleges were selected for UGC-CSIR/NET coaching classes. Sixty Six students registered and fifty seven students attended the coaching classes. 72 hours of classes (36 hours for chemistry and 36 hours for mathematics) on Saturdays and public holidays were given to them. For chemistry students, separate classes were taken on the topics namely, Organic and Inorganic Chemistry which includes IUPAC Nomenclature of bicyclo compounds and spiro compounds, aromaticity, Substitution and elimination reactions, configuration and conformation, chirality, topocity, electrocyclic reactions, cyclo addition reactions, sigmatropic rearrangements, NMR Spectroscopy, Mass and IR Spectroscopy. For Mathematics students classes

were taken on the topics of Real Analysis, Linear algebra, Differential equations, Complex analysis, Integral equations, and Abstract algebra. Resource persons were selected from their area of specialisation. These classes were very useful to students for performing well in UGC /CSIR-NET Examinations. Previous question papers were worked out by students and the doubts were cleared in the next classes by themselves. Printed study materials are also given to them. The coaching classes ended on 11th February 2023 and the certificates were distributed to the students.
