PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES IN GOVT/AIDED/ SELF-FINANCING ARTS AND SCIENCE COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF KERALA & CENTRES OF THE UNIVERSITY (UIT) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-2020

### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Prospectus for admission to the Post Graduate (PG) Degree Courses in Govt./Aided/Self financing Affiliated Colleges & Centres of the University, for the academic year **2019-20**, as approved by the University of Kerala, is published herewith. It contains general information and rules relating to the admission to PG Degree Courses in Govt./Aided/Self financing affiliated Colleges under the University of Kerala & Centres of the University.
- 1.2 ***The Prospectus issued by the University and various colleges during the previous years for PG admissions are not valid for the year 2019-20.***
- 1.3 Admissions to the seats to be filled by the University for the PG courses (except those specifically mentioned) are regulated on the basis of grade/marks obtained in the qualifying examination. The details of seats, to which admissions are made through the rank list prepared accordingly, are contained in the relevant paragraphs.
- 1.4 Statute 19 (3), of Chapter 24 of the KUFS 1977 which states that '**no student shall be admitted to any course of instruction in the colleges in anticipation of affiliation**', shall be strictly adhered to, in all the colleges.
- 1.5 Statute 31 of Chapter 24 of the KUFS 1977 which states that '**Admission of students to every College shall be subject to the conditions prescribed by the University and the strength of each class or subjects shall not exceed the maximum for the class or subject sanctioned by the Syndicate**' shall be strictly adhered to in all the Colleges.
- 1.6 **Authority to prescribe qualification for admission to the various courses of studies.**

According to Sub-Section (v) and (vi) of Section 25 of the Kerala University Act, 1974, the Academic Council shall have the power to prescribe qualifications for admission of students to the various courses of study (and to the Examinations) and the conditions under which exemptions shall be granted, and to make provision for the admission of students to the various courses of studies on the basis of merit in order to maintain the standards of education.
- 1.7 **Agreement for Direct Payment - Relevant provisions for admission to the various courses in Aided Colleges.**

Article 29 of the Agreement for Direct Payment entered into between the Government and the Educational Agencies of Private Colleges stipulates that all future admission of students to the Private Affiliated Colleges shall be on the following basis, viz :-

  - a) Twenty percent of the total number of seats in each college under the Educational Agency shall be reserved for students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. Those seats which cannot be filled on this basis shall be filled on the basis of merit from among backward minority communities, in case the college is run by a backward minority community and from among OBCs , in all other cases.
  - b) \*Ten/Twenty \*\*percent of the seats shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to the community to which the college belongs. These seats will be filled strictly on the basis of merit from among the students of the said community.
  - c) \*Fifty/Forty \*\*percent of the seats will be filled by open selection on the basis of merit.

d) The remaining seats will be filled by the Educational Agency by candidates of their choice.

*Note: \* This will apply to Forward Community Colleges*

*\*\* This will apply to Backward Community Colleges.*

**1.8 Admission to the following PG courses will not come under the purview of Centralised Allotment Process.**

**MBA, MCA, MAHRM, MPE, MSW, MFA, and MASLP.**

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**All candidates who desires to obtain admission under the University of Kerala for the PG Programme should compulsorily register online before the closure of registration, irrespective of the Category (General /SEBC/ EBFC/ SC/ST/ Community /Management / Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep/Jammu and Kashmir/ Malayalee students of Andaman / Persons With Disabilities (Differently Abled Persons) / Widows and Wards of Armed Forces Personnel Killed or Disabled in action during peace time /Sports etc.) to which he/she belongs.**

**No Online Registration shall be permitted after the closing date.**

**2. COURSES, INSTITUTIONS AND SEATS**

**2.1 Details of Courses and Duration:**

The course leads to Masters Degree in the relevant subject. The course extends for a period of four semesters. The course of study shall be by regular attendance for the requisite number of lectures, practical training and other means.

**2.2 Institutions and Subjects for the PG Degree Courses:**

The list of colleges to which admissions are to be made and the subjects offered and the total strength in each institution are given as Annexure –I, in the Prospectus.

**2.3 Categorization of Seats:**

Seats available in Govt/Aided/Self financing Affiliated Colleges/UIT's are mainly classified as Merit Seats/ Community seats/Management seats and Reservation seats.

**a. Merit Seats:**

The seats in Government/Aided/Self financing Affiliated Colleges/UIT's that are filled purely on merit basis irrespective of the Category/Community to which the candidates belong, are classified as "Merit Seats."

**b. Community Seats:**

The seats in Aided Colleges that are filled by the Colleges concerned, on the basis of merit from among the candidates who belong to the community of the Management who runs the College, are classified as 'Community Seats'.

**c. Management Seats:**

The seats in Aided and Self-financing affiliated Colleges that are to be filled by the Managements concerned are classified as "Management Seats."

**d. Reservation Seats:**

The seats in Government/Aided/Self-financing affiliated Colleges/ UIT's that are earmarked for SC/ST/SEBC/EBFC/PWD/Reservation for Nominees/Sports persons are classified as "Reservation Seats."

**3. RESERVATION OF SEATS**

Apart from the merit seats, the seats earmarked for SC/ST, SEBC, Economically Backward among Forward Communities (EBFC), PWD, TLM and Sports in Government/ Aided/ Self-financing Colleges/UIT's will be filled by the University.

### **3.1 Types of Reservations:**

Seats will be reserved for the following categories in Government/Aided/Self-financing Colleges/UITs for various PG courses.

#### **3.1.1 Reservation for Nominees:**

##### **a. Reservation for Candidates from Union Territory of Lakshadweep.**

An additional seat shall be created in all Government/Aided Colleges exclusively for the purpose of accommodating students sponsored by the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates. The Head of the Institutions should forward the list of such candidates admitted, separately, to the University, immediately after admissions (Govt. Letter No.5455/B3/2006/H Edn., dated 15.03.2006) (U.O.No.Ac.B/1/1134/2006 dated 26.04.2006). They should also register online before or after admission.

##### **b. Reservation for Candidates from Jammu and Kashmir.**

Two additional seats shall be created in all Affiliated Colleges exclusively for the purpose of accommodating candidates belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to PG courses from the academic year 2014 – 2015 onwards (U.O.No.Ac.B1/2292/Admns/2012 dated 01.03.2013). Such students should also register online before or after admission and approach Colleges for admission and the Principal should forward the list of such candidates after admission. These seats shall not be filled up by other candidates.

##### **c. Reservation for Malayalee students of Andaman.**

One Seat each be created for each PG course (only wherever necessary) in all affiliated Arts & Science Colleges under University of Kerala exclusively for the purpose of accommodating Malayalee students of Andaman. The colleges shall submit the list of such admitted students to the University, immediately after admissions along with the documents to prove that the student belongs to the Malayalee community in Andaman. This seat shall not be filled up by other candidates.

##### **d. Reservation of Seats for the Widows/Wards of Armed Forces Personnel Killed/Disabled in action during peace time.**

Additional seats over and above the sanctioned strength may be created as and when required for the widows/wards of Armed Forces Personnel killed/disabled in action during peace time in Central/ State Universities/ Autonomous Professional/Non-professional institutions under the purview of Ministry of Human Resources Development as per UGC policy.

#### **3.1.2 Reservation for Persons With Disabilities (PWD) -Differently Abled Persons**

5% seats of the sanctioned strength shall be created, over and above, exclusively for Physically Handicapped candidates in Government Colleges and Higher Education Institutions receiving aid from the Government (as per clause 32(1) of chapter VI, The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016). The applicants under this quota will be selected on the basis of existing rules.

One seat for each Post Graduate course in all other Colleges shall be reserved for Physically Handicapped candidates. These seats are over and above the sanctioned strength of the Course/subjects in the College and the same will be sanctioned by the University every year.

As per Clause 2 (r), Chapter I of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, 'Person with benchmark disability' means a person with not less than 40% of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority. Candidates who have a minimum of 40% disability alone will be eligible to apply for this quota. Candidates seeking admission under PWD category should submit the 'Certificate of disability', issued not earlier than 5 years prior to the submission

of application, by the District Medical Board or bodies of higher status, certifying the degree of percentage of disability. Based on the details furnished in the online application, candidates will be provisionally included under the 'Persons with Disability' category.

**The Permanent Disability Card issued by the State Government is also considered.**

Authorities of all Educational Institutions/Colleges affiliated to the University of Kerala are directed to make appropriate arrangements for Medical examination of students with disabilities at the place of counseling/admission, in the event of the authenticity of disability certificate being produced by the candidate is in doubt. Otherwise, the disability certificate issued by the appropriate authority should suffice. (Circular No.Ac.BI/PH/2011, dated 26.02.2011).

- ❖ The selection of candidates under this category will be based on the rank in the inter-se merit list and not on the basis of the degree of disability.
- ❖ **No reservation of seats is allowed for Blind candidates for Science subjects.**

**3.1.3 Special Reservation: -**

**(A) Sports Quota**

One seat shall be created over and above the sanctioned strength for sports persons in each subject for the Post Graduate Degree Programme. Admission to such seats shall be made as per the procedure for admission under sports quota. Admission to such seats shall be made by the Principal, from the ranklist approved by the University. If the required number of sports persons is not available, the seats should be kept vacant and shall not be filled by other candidates.

**Norms for Admission to the Seats Reserved Under Sports Quota for Post Graduate Courses**

1. Representing the country and winning the I/II/III in the International Competitions (Olympics, Approved World Competitions, Approved World University Competitions, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Afro-Asian Games, SAF Games, South Asian Championships etc.)
2. Representing the country in International Competitions (Olympics, Approved World Competitions, Approved World University Competitions, Commonwealth Games, Asian Games, Afro-Asian Games, SAF Games, South Asian Championships etc.)
3. Winning the I/II/III in the Senior National Championships.
4. Winning the I/II/III/IV in the All India Inter -University Competitions.
5. Representing Senior State in National Championships.
6. Winning the I/II/III in the Junior/Youth National Championships.
7. Winning the I/II/III/IV in the Zonal Inter-University Competitions.
8. Representing Senior State in South Zone Championship.
9. Representing University in Inter -University Competitions.
10. Representing the state in the Junior/Youth National Championships.
11. Representing the state in the Junior/Youth Zone Championships.
12. Winning the I/II/III place in the All Kerala Inter-Collegiate (College Games) organized by Kerala Sports Council.
13. Winning the I/II/III place in the Senior/Junior Inter District Championships.
14. **Winning the I/II/III in the University Intercollegiate Competitions\*.**
15. Participating in the State Championships.

### General Guidelines

- i. For filling up the seats reserved under Sports quota, hierarchy of preference shall be given as per the norms/guidelines formulated by the University in addition to his /her satisfying academic eligibility.
- ii. When the candidates fulfil minimum academic eligibility, the academic merit shall not be preferred over Sports merit in Sports quota reservation seats, except in the case of a tie in the sports merit.
- iii. The original certificate/s from the Competent authority/ authorities (Secretary, Organizer etc. as per the Circular Letter No.Ad.D1.3.1276/74 dtd 23.01.1979) must be produced by the candidate to prove his/her claim.
- iv. The verification of the certificate/s shall be done by the Head of the Department of Physical Education of the College and the ranklist thus prepared shall verified by the Director, Department of Physical Education of the University.
- v. For securing admission to PG programmes under Sports quota, including readmission, the performance of the candidate during the preceding three years shall be considered.
- vi. Preferences shall be given to those disciplines which have All India Inter-University Competitions.
- vii. In case of a tie, with respect to the Sports merit, preference shall be given to that candidate who represents the discipline (Game/Sport) of the choice of the college concerned.
- viii. **The achievement certificate received before the closure of registration of PG Programmes will only be considered for ranking in sports quota admissions.**

### Mode of admission under Sports Quota in Affiliated Colleges and UIT's

1. The Sports Quota admission shall be effected in online mode only. (Item no.06.33.04 of the Minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate dated 11.03.2019)
2. Candidates who seek admission under sports quota should apply online within the prescribed time. They need not submit the application for sports quota admission in colleges.
3. The certificates of achievement shall be scanned and uploaded in the website. **The time for uploading the certificates will be intimated later.**
4. After verification of the certificates, the ranklist will be published in admission website and Colleges concerned.
5. The admission will be effected by the Principal based on this ranklist.
6. **The instructions for registration for sports quota admission will be published later.**

**No Sports Quota applications will be entertained after the last date of registration. Only those candidates who upload the supporting sports achievement certificate within the prescribed time will only be considered for admission under sports quota.**

The candidates should register for sports quota admission through online mode by uploading their certificates of achievements within the prescribed time. After verification of the certificates, the ranklist will be published in admission website and Colleges concerned. Admissions shall be made in colleges based on this ranklist.

**IMPORTANT : THE SEATS FOR RESERVATION UNDER PWD AND SPORTS QUOTA ARE CREATED OVER AND ABOVE THE SANCTIONED STRENGTH. IN THE ABSENCE OF THE CANDIDATES WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THESE RESERVATIONS, SUCH SEATS WILL REMAIN UNFILLED.**

**(B) Arts Quota**

Students who are declared as Kalaprathibha / Kalathilakam of the University of Kerala in any year during their Degree course, and who are applicants for PG Course in a College affiliated to this University, during the succeeding academic year shall be admitted to the PG course/College of his/her first option, if otherwise eligible, by creating seats over and above the sanctioned strength.

**\*Candidates who enjoy Communal Reservation such as SEBC, SC/ST who have BPL endorsement in the Ration Card are NOT eligible for EBFC reservation. Only candidates belonging to FORWARD COMMUNITIES who are Economically Backward are eligible for EBFC reservation. Such candidates must produce BPL Certificate from the Village Officer/Revenue Authority /Local Body concerned along with community certificate from the competent authority. In case of failure to specify the community, the candidate shall not be eligible for reservation in the EBFC category.**

**Note:**

- SEBC candidates should produce Non Creamy layer Certificate for getting the benefit of reservation.
- The enhancement of additional seats in Government colleges and University departments shall not incur any additional financial commitment to the Government /University.

**If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates, the same will be notified in the media three times (on three different dates) and a separate allotment for SC/ST candidates will be made by the University. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats are still vacant, such seats in Government Colleges/UIT's will be filled by candidates belonging to Other Eligible Communities (OEC) included in the Annexure IV of the Prospectus and in their absence, candidates belonging to SEBC strictly in accordance with the rules and guidelines on admission of candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Communities (SEBC). The seats that still remain un-availed will go to the Open Merit Quota.**

**Note: The fee structure of the UIT's is higher than that of Govt/Aided Colleges.**

### **Mode of admission under Community Quota in Aided Colleges**

1. The seats under community quota in Aided Colleges will be filled by the Colleges concerned on the basis of merit and on the basis of community certificate issued by the Revenue Authorities/Parish Priest/any other Competent Authority.
2. The Community Quota registration will be effected in online mode (Item no.06.33.03 of the Minutes of the meeting of the Syndicate dated 11.03.2019). Candidates need not submit the application for community quota admission in colleges. **No registrations exclusively for community quota will be permissible.** They can use the application number of their original registration and submit online application for Community Quota separately.
3. Maximum 20 options may be given to students. **The options given by the candidate during online registration for merit seats will not be considered under any circumstances.**
4. From the applications submitted, the University will prepare ranklist of the eligible candidates and the same will be forwarded to the colleges concerned.
5. The eligible students who appear in the ranklist will be notified to appear at the opted college for certificate verification, and admission thereafter based on the rank and number of vacant seats.
6. All admissions to Community Quota (including the vacant seats of SC/ST converted in case of Aided Backward colleges with Minority status) are to be effected from the Community Quota Ranklist of the colleges approved by the University. The final approved ranklist will be published in the college notice board and in the admission website.
7. **The time for registration for Community Quota and the instructions for registration will be published later.**

### **List of communities that are considered for Community Quota Admission in various Aided Colleges are given in Annexure VI**

**No applications will be entertained after the last date of registration.**

**If sufficient candidates are not available for filling the seats reserved for SC/ST candidates in Aided Colleges, the same will be notified in the media three times (on three different dates) and a separate allotment for SC/ST candidates will be made by the University. However, even after this, if SC/ST seats are still vacant, same will be filled as per the following norms.**

1. **The vacant SC/ST seats if any, in Aided Forward/Backward Colleges will be filled by admitting candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Communities (SEBC) strictly in accordance with the rules and guidelines on admission.**
2. **The vacant SC/ST seats if any, in Backward Aided colleges with Minority Status will be filled by admitting candidates from the Community Quota Ranklist of the colleges strictly in accordance with the rules and guidelines on admission.**

**(c) Self-Financing Affiliated Colleges: 50% seats will be filled on the basis of merit as detailed below.**

The remaining 50% of the seats shall be filled by the management, by candidates of their choice, observing the prescribed eligibility conditions.

**Note: The fee structure of the Self-financing Colleges is higher than that of Govt/Aided Colleges. Government fee concession is not available to candidates enjoying communal reservation, if admitted in Self- financing Colleges.**

### **Mode of admission under Management Quota in Aided and Self Financing Colleges**

1. The candidates seeking admission to the management quota in Aided and Self Financing colleges should register online.
2. Candidates should contact the colleges he/she intends to take admission and submit the printout of the application form to the colleges concerned.
3. **The candidates can apply under Management Quota till the closure of admission.**

**The Management quota applications can be used only for admission to Management quota seats.**

#### **4. CLAIMS FOR MANDATORY RESERVATION AND CERTIFICATES TO BE PRODUCED**

Claims for Mandatory Reservations must be made by a candidate at the time of submission of online application. Candidates should also mention the item of reservation claimed in the relevant columns in the online application. Candidates should also satisfy the eligibility conditions as per Clause 5 of the Prospectus. **The claims for mandatory reservation once made in the application cannot be altered by the candidate under any circumstances.**

##### **4.1 Claims for Reservation –SEBC, SC/ST and OEC**

###### **4.1.1 Claim for Communal reservation under ‘Socially and Educationally Backward Classes’ (SEBC):**

Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, as amended from time to time.

- a. Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindus, Latin Catholic/SIUC and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC quota should invariably produce both “Community” and ‘Non Creamy Layer Certificate’ obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Candidate belonging to Non Creamy Layer category only are eligible for claiming reservation to SEBC category. Annual Income is not a criterion for reservation for SEBC candidates.
- b. The communities under OEC which is also included under OBH/OBX categories, will be considered for reservation along with OBH/OBX. Such candidates should furnish Community and Non Creamy Layer Certificate obtained from the Village Officer concerned.
- b. Applicants claiming reservation under community quota in aided colleges (ref. Annexure I), who belong to the community of the Management which runs the college, will have to submit the Community Certificate obtained from the Revenue Authority/ Parish Priest/ any other Competent Authority concerned, at the time of admission.

###### **4.1.2 Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Quota**

Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the Caste/Community Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar.

**Those who produce false SC/ST Certificate for claiming reservation under SC/ST quota shall be liable for penalties as per rules.**

**The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidates and vice versa.**

###### **4.1.3 Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates.**

Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates who claim allotment to the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota (ref. Annexure IV) should furnish community certificate obtained from the Village Officer/Tahsildar. OEC candidates who possess ‘Non Creamy layer Certificate’ obtained from the Village Officer concerned alone are eligible for such seats.

**Note : Converted Christians do not come under the SC/ST category. They belong to OEC category. (Ref. Annexure IV)**
